Dear Chuck and Jane:

Several months have passed since we received your letter containing a one-ounce sample of Kel-Crete Super Dry Admixture. As you know, our company has become a true believer in Kel-Crete Industries' products, and use them exclusively in our plastering operations throughout the state of Texas. We do so for common sense reasons which include overall material and labor cost savings, and the best possible end results in the quality of our projects.

After sin Kel-Crete products for some time we came to you with the request to be your distributor for Kel-Crete products for the state of Texas and Mexico. We discussed the possibility that if this should happen we would have to form a separate company dedicated to marketing and distribution. We formed DURO-Crete, Inc. for this purpose, and as you know the rest is history.

Since the above has taken place both of our companies, yours and ours, have experienced success stories, and the reason I am giving you this letter.

Our material cost savings is due to the simple fact that two to three ounces of Kel-Crete Liquid replaces as much as 25 lbs. of lime, and one gallon of Kel-Crete replaces as much as 32 sacks of lime.
