Kel-Prime Specifications & Applications

Note: Kel-Prime is a multi-functional product that is highly concentrated for a number of applications.

- A. Mixing one gallon of Kel-Prime with one gallon of clean tap water will cover 800 square feet of area and will provide a bonding surface for the following applications:
 - 1. Finish stucco plaster over:
 - a. brown coat plaster
 - b. one coat plaster
 - c. CMU block, concrete, brick, etc.
 - d. gypsum board
 - e. vinyl
 - f. glass
 - g. steel
 - 2. Curing, hardening and waterproofing over:
 - a. finish coat plaster
 - b. one coat plaster
 - c. concrete
 - d. shotcrete
 - e. rockscapes
 - f. waterscapes
 - g. block

Paint primer over:

- a. gypsum
- b. block
- c. concrete
- d. steel
- e. wood
- f. plaster
- g. shotcrete
- h. etc.
- 3. Paint additive to create elastomeric paint. Add 8 ozs. per one gallon of latex paint. Box paint five times.
- 4. Application using sprayer, brush, roller, etc:
 Apply one good coat only. **Do not overlap** after the first application has dried.
- **5.** Cleanup: Clean with water after using all equipment, brushes, rollers, etc. **This is important.**
- 6. Do not allow Kel-Prime to dry on any surface that you do not want the application on.

- 7. Kel-Prime is shipped on 4 one-gallon containers. This will weigh forty pounds and the box measures 12"x12". It also comes in 55-gallon drums weighing 538 pounds.
